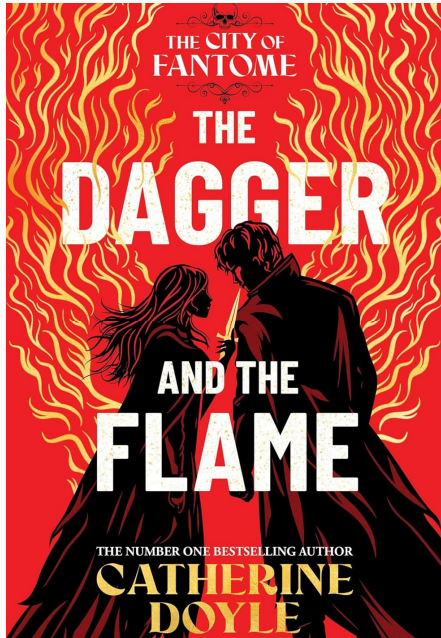

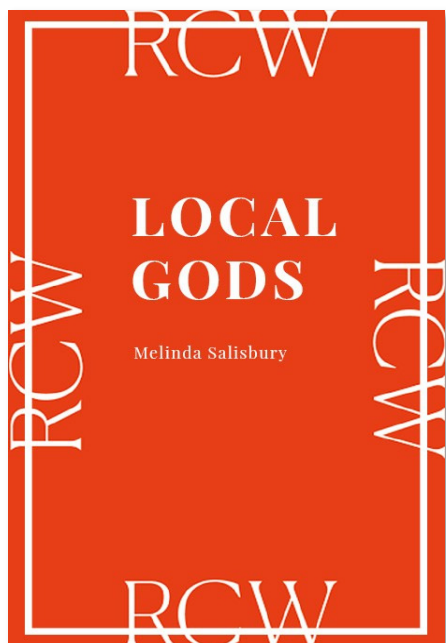

The town is a tinder box. And Sylvie Singer is the spark that will either save it or burn it all down.
